

**Tasting Notes:**

Only 165 case of the PALMERI Syrah were produced in 2001, the first release from the talents of Kerry Damskey, Daisy Damskey, and Denise Prentice.

Kerry describes the wine as “Purple-black in color, drawing you in with a sensual New World boldness. This fruit-forward Syrah offers aromas that include coffee beans, allspice, cocoa, cedar and forest floor; all of which marry perfectly in a layer of black pepper, cassis, and blackberry. Chewy in texture, back of the throat smooth, and a full mouth, leading to an extraordinary, lasting finish.”
